THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 4 section 44a is added to read as follows:
- Sec. 27a. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection
- 6 (2), property shall be assessed at -50% THE FOLLOWING PERCENTAGE
- 7 of its true cash value pursuant to section 3 of article $\frac{-9}{2}$ IX of
- 8 the state constitution of 1963: -

- 1 (A) THROUGH DECEMBER 30, 1990, 50%.
- 2 (B) FROM DECEMBER 31, 1990 THROUGH DECEMBER 30, 1991, 45%.
- 3 (C) FROM DECEMBER 31, 1991 THROUGH DECEMBER 30, 1992,
- 4 42.5%.
- 5 (D) FROM DECEMBER 31, 1992 THROUGH DECEMBER 30, 1993, 40%.
- 6 (2) Assessment of property, as required in this section and
- 7 section 27, shall be inapplicable to the assessment of property
- 8 subject to the levy of ad valorem taxes within voted tax limita-
- 9 tion increases to pay principal and interest on limited tax bonds
- 10 issued by any governmental unit, including a county, township,
- 11 community college district, or school district, before January 1,

- 21 OPERATING PURPOSES ON HIS OR HER HOMESTEAD PROPERTY:
- 22 (A) FOR TAXES THAT BECOME A LIEN ON THE PROPERTY IN 1990,
- 23 50%.
- 24 (B) FOR TAXES THAT BECOME A LIEN ON THE PROPERTY IN 1991,
- 25 75%.
- 26 (C) FOR TAXES THAT BECOME A LIEN ON THE PROPERTY AFTER 1991,
