

HOUSE BILL No. 6007

September 13, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Sofio, Joe Young, Jr., Weeks, Stupak and Jacobetti and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in Houghton county; and to prescribe conditions for the conveyance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. The state administrative board, on behalf of the
2 state, may convey to the city of Hancock for a consideration of
3 \$1.00 property currently under the jurisdiction of the department
4 of management and budget, formerly known as the department of
5 administration, which property is located in the city of Hancock,
6 Houghton county, Michigan, and is more particularly described as
7 follows:

8 Lots number one (1) and two (2), Block number one (1), City
9 of Hancock, according to the Plat thereof.

10 Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by
11 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general and shall reserve

1 to the state all rights to coal, oil, gas and other mineral
2 rights, excluding sand, gravel, clay, or other nonmetallic miner-
3 als found on, within, or under the conveyed lands.

4 Sec. 3. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-
5 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
