A bill to prohibit refiners from setting the retail price of motor fuel; to prohibit a refiner from requiring that a retailer purchase motor fuel only from certain distributors; and to prescribe penalties.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Affiliate" means a person who, other than by means of a
- 3 franchise, controls, is controlled by, or is under common control
- 4 with any other person.
- 5 (b) "Contract" means any oral or written agreement.
- 6 (c) "Distributor" means a person, including any affiliate of
- 7 a person, who does either of the following:
- 8 (i) Purchases motor fuel for sale, consignment, or
- 9 distribution to a retailer.

- 1 (ii) Receives motor fuel on consignment for consignment or
- 2 distribution to accounts of a franchisor. Distributor does not
- 3 include a person who is a common carrier providing only transpor-
- 4 tation services.
- 5 (d) "Franchise" means a contract between a refiner and a
- 6 retailer under which a refiner authorizes or permits a retailer
- 7 to use, in connection with the sale of motor fuel, a trademark
- 8 which is owned or controlled by a refiner. Franchise includes,
- 9 but is not limited to, a contract pertaining to the supply of
- ${f 10}$ fuel which is to be sold under a trademark owned or controlled by
- 11 a refiner.
- (e) "Franchisee" means a retailer who is authorized or per-
- 13 mitted under a franchise to use a trademark in connection with
- 14 the sale of motor fuel.
- (f) "Franchisor" means a refiner who authorizes or permits
- 16 under a franchise a retailer to use a trademark in connection
- 17 with the sale of motor fuel.
- (q) "Motor fuel" means gasoline and diesel fuel of a type
- 19 distributed for use as a fuel in self-propelled vehicles designed
- 20 primarily for use on public streets, roads, and highways.
- 21 (h) "Person" means an individual, partnership, association,
- 22 corporation, or any other legal entity.
- 23 (i) "Refiner" means a person or an affiliate of that person
- 24 engaged in the refining of crude oil to produce motor fuel.
- 25 (j) "Retailer" means a person who purchases motor fuel for
- 26 sale to the general public.

- Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the terms of the franchise, a
- 2 franchisor shall not do either of the following:
- 3 (a) Set the retail price at which the franchisee shall sell
- 4 motor fuel.
- 5 (b) Except to limit purchases to the franchisor's motor
- 6 fuel, require the franchisee to purchase motor fuel from a spe-
- 7 cific distributor of the franchisor's motor fuel.
- 8 Sec. 3. A person who violates this act is guilty of a mis-
- 9 demeanor, punishable by imprisonment for not more than 1 year or
- 10 by a fine of not more than \$10,000.00, or both.
