

HOUSE BILL No. 6033

September 13, 1990, Introduced by Rep. Law and referred to the Committee on State Affairs.

A bill to provide for cooperative purchasing agreements between this state and other states; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state departments and officers.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
2 "multistate cooperative purchasing agreements act".

3 Sec. 2. This state may enter into a cooperative purchasing
4 agreement with 1 or more of the other states for the purchase of
5 items necessary for the performance, financing, or execution of
6 the functions of this state upon the consent of each state
7 involved.

8 Sec. 3. A cooperative purchasing agreement shall include
9 all of the following:

10 (a) A description of the items to be purchased.

1 (b) The manner in which the items purchased will be
2 transferred to each state.

3 (c) The method of financing to be used and the amount to be
4 paid by each state.

5 (d) Other legal, financial, and administrative arrangements
6 necessary to effectuate the agreement.

7 (e) The term of the agreement.

8 (f) The effective date of the agreement.

9 Sec. 4. The department of management and budget shall
10 administer a cooperative purchasing agreement under this act if
11 the agreement meets all of the following requirements:

12 (a) The agreement is approved by resolution of the legisla-
13 tive body of each state.

14 (b) The terms of the agreement are entered in the journal of
15 proceedings of the legislative body of each state.

16 (c) A copy of the agreement is filed with the secretary of
17 state before the effective date of the agreement.

18 Sec. 5. A joint board or commission may be established by
19 the states that are parties to a cooperative purchasing agreement
20 to supervise the execution of the agreement. The director of the
21 department of management and budget, or his or her designee, may
22 serve on or with any joint board or commission created under this
23 section and shall not be required to relinquish his or her office
24 or employment by reason of that service.

25 Sec. 6. A cooperative purchasing agreement may be amended
26 by agreement of the parties to the cooperative purchasing
27 agreement in the same manner as the original agreement was made.

1 A cooperative purchasing agreement may be terminated by joint
2 action of all parties to the cooperative purchasing agreement, or
3 by an individual party to the agreement not less than 1 year
4 after the notice of termination by that party is delivered in
5 writing to all other parties to the agreement.
