

HOUSE BILL No. 6245

November 8, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Alley, DeMars, Dolan and Kosteva and referred to the Committee on Conservation, Recreation and Environment.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 329 of the Public Acts of 1988, entitled
"Recreation bond implementation act,"
being section 318.572 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 329 of the Public Acts of
2 1988, being section 318.572 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

5 (a) "Bonds" means the bonds issued under the recreation bond
6 authorization act.

7 (b) "Commission" means the commission of ~~natural resources~~
8 CONSERVATION AND RECREATION.

9 (c) "Department" means the department of natural resources.

1 (d) "Fund" means the recreation bond fund created in
2 section 6.

3 (e) "Local public recreation project" means capital improve-
4 ment projects including, but not limited to, the construction,
5 expansion, development, or rehabilitation of recreational facili-
6 ties, and the restoration of the natural environment. It does
7 not include the operation, maintenance, or administration of such
8 facilities, wages, or administration of projects or purchase of
9 facilities already dedicated to public recreational purposes.

10 (f) "Local unit of government" means a county, city, town-
11 ship, village, school district, the Huron-Clinton metropolitan
12 authority, or any authority composed of counties, cities, town-
13 ships, villages, or school districts, or any combination thereof,
14 which authority is legally constituted to provide public
15 recreation.

16 (g) "Rule" means a rule promulgated pursuant to the adminis-
17 trative procedures act of 1969, Act No. 306 of the Public Acts of
18 1969, being sections 24.201 to 24.328 of the Michigan Compiled
19 Laws.

20 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
21 all of the following bills of the 85th Legislature are enacted
22 into law:
