THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 2 and 7 of Act No. 221 of the Public
- 2 Act of 1987, being sections 318.532 and 318.537 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 5 (a) "Associated facilities" means restrooms, shelters, camp-
- 6 grounds, and parking lots, which directly relate to trails or
- 7 waterways projects.
- 8 (b) "Commission" means the commission of natural resources
- 9 CONSERVATION AND RECREATION.

- 1 (c) "Department" means the department of natural resources.
- 2 (d) "Director" means the director of the department.
- 3 (e) "Fund" means the recreation improvement fund created in 4 section 5.
- 5 (f) "Michigan state waterways fund" means the Michigan state
- 6 waterways fund created in section 8 of Act No. 320 of the Public
- 7 Acts of 1947, being section 281.508 of the Michigan Compiled
- 8 Laws.
- 9 (g) "Off-road vehicle" means ORV as it is defined in section
- 10 1 of Act No. 319 of the Public Acts of 1975, being section
- 11 257.1601 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, which are required to be

- 14 (h) "Recreational projects" means, in addition to the activ-
- 15 ities provided for in this act, the construction, maintenance,

- 18 riders, and hikers; and inland lake cleanup grants as provided by
- 19 the inland lake improvement act of 1966, Act No. 345 of the

- (i) "Recreational snowmobile trail improvement fund" means
- 23 the recreational snowmobile trail improvement fund created in

- 26 (j) "Vessel" means all watercraft except the following:

- 1 (i) Watercraft used for commercial fishing.
- 2 (ii) Watercraft used by the Sea Scout department of the Boy
- 3 Scouts of America chiefly for training scouts in seamanship.
- 4 (iii) Watercraft owned by this state or any political subdi-
- 5 vision of this state or by the federal government.
- 6 (iv) Watercraft, when used in interstate or foreign com-
- 7 merce, and watercraft used or owned by any railroad company or
- 8 railroad car ferry company.
- 9 (v) Watercraft, when used in trade, including watercraft
- 10 when used in connection with an activity which constitutes a
- 11 person's chief business or means of livelihood.
- (k) "Watercraft" means any contrivance now known or hereaf-
- 13 ter invented, used, or designed for navigation on water, includ-
- 14 ing, but not limited to, any vessel, ship, boat, motor vessel,
- 15 steam vessel, vessel operated by machinery, motorboat, sailboat,
- 16 barge, scow, tugboat, and rowboat, except watercraft used or
- 17 owned by the United States.
- 18 Sec. 7. The department of treasury shall annually present
- 19 to the commission of natural resources CONSERVATION AND
- 20 RECREATION an accurate total of all the gasoline taxes collected
- 21 and determine the amount of revenue derived from them. The
- 22 department of treasury shall determine the portion of these reve-
- 23 nues derived from the sale of gasoline as described in section 3
- 24 by multiplying the total by 2.0% and shall credit this amount to
- 25 the recreation improvement fund, less a deduction for collection
- 26 costs and refunds.

- Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless 2 all of the following bills of the 85th Legislature are enacted 3 into law:
