THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 4 Sec. 5. A member of a reciprocal retirement system, who
- 5 has -5- 30 MONTHS or more -years of credited service acquired as

- 7 met the service requirements for age and service retirement shall
- 8 be entitled to use his OR HER credited service in force
- 9 previously acquired as a member of governmental unit retirement
- 10 systems in meeting the service requirements of the system from

- 1 which he OR SHE retires. If he OR SHE has a break in
- 2 governmental unit employment for a period longer than 5 years,
- 3 his OR HER service rendered in the employ of the governmental
- 4 units prior to his OR HER last break in service shall not be used
- 5 in satisfying the service requirement for age and service retire-
- 6 ment in the system from which he OR SHE retires. Credited serv-
- 7 ice acquired in a governmental unit in which he OR SHE was previ-
- 8 ously employed shall not be used in determining the amount of his
- 9 OR HER retirement allowance payable by the reciprocal retirement
- 10 system from which he OR SHE retires unless otherwise provided by
- 11 the retirement system provisions.
