- 1 for a senior citizen shall be \$1.00. The fee for a nonresident
- 2 wild turkey hunting license shall be \$\frac{\\$25.00}{}\$ \$75.00. A person
- 3 who is issued a small game license may make an application to the
- 4 department for a wild turkey hunting license. Applications for a
- 5 license to hunt wild turkeys shall be entered into a lottery
- 6 designed and run by the department. A person selected in the
- 7 lottery shall upon meeting the requirements of this act receive a
- 8 wild turkey hunting license. The license shall be issued for a
- 9 specified hunting period and shall confer upon the holder of the
- 10 license the right to hunt wild turkeys.
- (2) The fees collected for wild turkey hunting licenses
- 12 shall be used for scientific research, biological survey work on
