## **HOUSE BILL No. 5694**

May 1, 1990, Introduced by Rep. Hickner and referred to the Committee on Liquor Control.

A bill to amend section 28c of Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, entitled as amended "The Michigan liquor control act," as added by Act No. 132 of the Public Acts of 1988, being section

436.28c of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 28c of Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of
- 2 the Extra Session of 1933, as added by Act No. 132 of the Public
- 3 Acts of 1988, being section 436.28c of the Michigan Compiled
- 4 Laws, is amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 28c. (1) The commission shall not prohibit an appli-

- 1 (a) One or more of the following conditions exists:
- 2 (i) The applicant or licensee is located in a neighborhood
- 3 shopping center composed of 1 or more commercial establishments
- 4 organized or operated as a unit which is related in location,
- 5 size, and type of shop to the trade area that the unit serves,
- 6 which provides not less than 50,000 square feet of gross leasable
- 7 retail space, and which provides 5 private off-street parking
- 8 spaces for each 1,000 square feet of gross leasable retail
- 9 space.
- 10 (ii) The applicant or licensee maintains a minimum inventory
- 11 on the premises, excluding alcoholic liquor and motor vehicle
- 12 fuel, of not less than \$250,000.00, at cost, of those goods and
- 13 services customarily marketed by approved types of businesses.

- 6 adjacent to the licensed premises if -all BOTH of the following

- 8 (a) The applicant or licensee is located in a city, incorpo-
- 9 rated village, or township of -3,000 3,500 population or less.

- (4) -(4)(a) A person who was issued a specially designated
- 16 merchant license or specially designated distributor license at a
- 17 location at which another person owned, operated or maintained
- 18 motor vehicle fuel pumps at the same location may have or acquire
- 19 an interest in the ownership, operation or maintenance of those
- 20 motor vehicle fuel pumps.
- 21 (5) (b) The commission may transfer ownership of a spe-
- 22 cially designated merchant license or specially designated dis-
- 23 tributor license to a person who owns or is acquiring an interest
- 24 in motor vehicle fuel pumps already in operation at the same
- 25 location at which the license is issued.
- 26 (5) The commission and the department of commerce shall
- 27 conduct a study to obtain information and examine the feasibility

- 1 of issuing specially designated distributor licenses and
- 2 specially designated merchant licenses to types of businesses
- 3 other than those described in subsection (1) that sell motor
- 4 vehicle fuel. A report of the results of the study shall be pro-
- 5 vided to the legislature not later than December 31, 1988.
