HOUSE BILL No. 5706

May 3, 1990, Introduced by Reps. Niederstadt, Weeks and DeBeaussaert and referred to the Committee on Towns and Counties.

A bill to require the use and recording of certain documents regarding trusts in the case of real property that is conveyed or otherwise affected by a trust.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. An instrument conveying, encumbering, or otherwise
- 2 affecting an interest in real property, executed pursuant to an
- 3 express trust, shall be accompanied either by a copy of the trust
- 4 agreement or by a certificate of trust existence and authority,
- 5 as described in sections 2 and 3.
- 6 Sec. 2. A certificate of trust existence and authority
- 7 shall contain all of the following information:
- 8 (a) The title of the trust.
- 9 (b) The date of the trust agreement.
- (c) The name of the settlor or grantor and the settlor's or grantor's address.

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- (d) The names of all of the trustees and successor trustees
 and their names and addresses.
- 3 (e) Exact copies of sections of the trust agreement regard-
- 4 ing all of the following:
- 5 (i) Establishment of the trust.
- 6 (ii) The powers of the trustee or trustees and restrictions7 on the trustee or trustees.
- 8 (iii) The governing law.
- 9 (iv) Revocation or amendment of the trust.
- 10 (v) Appointment of a successor trustee or trustees.
- 11 Sec. 3. A certificate of trust existence and authority
- 12 shall be executed by the settlor or grantor or the attorney who
- 13 drafted the trust agreement. The certificate shall be in the
- 14 form of an affidavit.
- 15 Sec. 4. The trust agreement or certificate of trust exis-
- 16 tence and authority, and any amendments to or revocations of the
- 17 trust agreement or the certificate of trust existence and author-
- 18 ity, shall be recorded in the office of the register of deeds of
- 19 each county where the lands that are the subject of or affected
- 20 by the trust agreement are located.
