

# SENATE BILL No. 33

January 11, 1989, Introduced by Senators DILLINGHAM, CHERRY, EHLERS,  
GEO. HART, CROPSEY, and FESSLER and referred to the Committee on  
Health Policy.

A bill to amend Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978,  
entitled as amended  
"Public health code,"  
as amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan  
Compiled Laws, by adding section 21794.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, as  
2 amended, being sections 333.1101 to 333.25211 of the Michigan  
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 21794 to read as  
4 follows:

5 SEC. 21794. (1) A NURSING HOME SHALL ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT AN  
6 IN-SERVICE TRAINING PROGRAM THAT PROVIDES INSTRUCTION ON DEMENTIA  
7 AND THE TECHNIQUES NECESSARY TO MANAGE THE PHYSICAL,  
8 INTELLECTUAL, AND BEHAVIORAL MANIFESTATIONS OF DEMENTIA IN  
9 PATIENTS. AFTER JULY 1, 1989, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT ISSUE OR

1 RENEW A NURSING HOME LICENSE UNLESS THE NURSING HOME ADOPTS AND  
2 IMPLEMENTS AN IN-SERVICE TRAINING PROGRAM THAT COMPLIES WITH THIS  
3 SECTION FOR ALL NURSING HOME EMPLOYEES AND STAFF.

4       (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE RULES TO ADMINISTER THIS  
5 SECTION.
