

SENATE BILL No. 80

February 1, 1989, Introduced by Senator FESSLER and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Veterans.

A bill to amend Act No. 279 of the Public Acts of 1909,
entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the incorporation of cities and for revising and amending their charters; to provide for certain powers and duties; to provide for the levy and collection of taxes by cities, borrowing of money, and issuance of bonds or other evidences of indebtedness; to validate actions taken, bonds issued, and obligations heretofore incurred; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts on specific dates,"

as amended, being sections 117.1 to 117.38 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 34a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 279 of the Public Acts of 1909, as
2 amended, being sections 117.1 to 117.38 of the Michigan Compiled
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 34a to read as follows:

4 SEC. 34A. A CITY SHALL NOT REQUIRE BY CHARTER OR ORDINANCE
5 AND THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE CITY SHALL NOT REQUIRE THAT A
6 POLICE OFFICER EMPLOYED BY THE CITY OR AN APPLICANT FOR

1 EMPLOYMENT AS A POLICE OFFICER RESIDE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS
2 OF THE CITY.
