February 1, 1989, Introduced by Senator FESSLER and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Veterans.

A bill to amend section 12 of Act No. 359 of the Public Acts of 1947, entitled

"An act to authorize the incorporation of charter townships; to provide a municipal charter therefor; and to prescribe the powers and functions thereof,"

being section 42.12 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 12 of Act No. 359 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1947, being section 42.12 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 12. The township board in each charter township may
- 5 provide for and establish a police force and authorize the super-
- 6 visor, or the township superintendent if one has been appointed,
- 7 to appoint, subject to the approval of the -said board, a
- 8 township marshal and such other -policemen- POLICE OFFICERS and
- 9 watchmen as may be required to protect property and preserve the

- 1 public welfare and safety in that portion of the township not
- 2 included within the corporate limits of any village or villages
- 3 located wholly or in part within the township. No- A police
- 4 officer of any such village shall NOT be ineligible for appoint-
- 5 ment as a member of the township police force, except that no-
- 6 BUT A village police officer shall NOT serve as township
- 7 marshal. The township board shall make all necessary rules for
- 8 the government of the township police force and its members and
- 9 shall prescribe the powers and duties of -policemen- POLICE
- 10 OFFICERS and watchmen, and may invest them with such authority as
- 11 may be necessary for the preservation of quiet and order and the
- 12 protection of persons and property within that part of the town-
- 13 ship not located within the corporate limits of any village.
- 14 HOWEVER, THE TOWNSHIP BOARD SHALL NOT REQUIRE THAT A POLICE OFFI-
- 15 CER EMPLOYED BY THE TOWNSHIP OR AN APPLICANT FOR EMPLOYMENT AS A
- 16 POLICE OFFICER RESIDE WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP.
