SENATE BILL No. 170

February 22, 1989, Introduced by Senator KELLY and referred to the Committee on State Affairs, Tourism, and Transportation.

A bill to amend section 7 of Act No. 348 of the Public Acts of 1972, entitled

"An act to regulate relationships between landlords and tenants relative to rental agreements for rental units; to regulate the payment, repayment, use and investment of security deposits; to provide for commencement and termination inventories of rental units; to provide for termination arrangements relative to rental units; to provide for legal remedies; and to provide penalties,"

being section 554.607 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 7 of Act No. 348 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1972, being section 554.607 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 7. (1) A SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), A security
- 5 deposit may be used only for the following purposes:
- 6 (a) Reimburse REIMBURSING the landlord for actual damages
- 7 to the rental unit or any ancillary facility that are the direct

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- 1 result of conduct not reasonably expected in the normal course of
 2 habitation of a dwelling.
- 3 (b) Pay PAYING the landlord for all rent in arrearage
- 4 under the rental agreement, rent due for premature termination of
- 5 the rental agreement by the tenant, and for utility bills not
- 6 paid by the tenant.
- 7 (2) A SECURITY DEPOSIT SHALL NOT BE USED FOR RENT DUE FOR
- 8 PREMATURE TERMINATION OF THE RENTAL AGREEMENT BY THE TENANT IF
- 9 THE TERMINATION OCCURS BECAUSE THE TENANT HAS DIED OR HAS BECOME
- 10 INCAPACITATED. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "INCAPACITATED" MEANS
- 11 INCAPABLE OF RESIDING ALONE IN THE RENTAL UNIT BECAUSE OF A PHYS-
- 12 ICAL OR MENTAL CONDITION.
