"An act to provide for employing the convicts in the custody of the department of corrections upon public projects other than construction within any county,"

being section 800.101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 181 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1911, being section 800.101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 1. Upon the written request of a majority of the
- 5 COUNTY board of commissioners, the department of corrections may
- 6 detail such able bodied convicts PRISONERS as in its discre-
- 7 tion shall seem THE DEPARTMENT CONSIDERS proper, not exceeding
- 8 the number specified in the written request, to work upon public
- 9 projects of a county. The county shall pay to the general fund a

- 2 detailed, which amount shall be decided upon by the DIRECTOR OF

- 5 The county shall pay expenses of transportation to and from the
- 6 county and shall provide or pay for the lodging and food of the
- 7 -convicts PRISONERS while employed by it and shall furnish all
- 8 tools and materials necessary in the performance of the work.
- 9 The -convicts PRISONERS employed upon the public projects shall
- 10 be under the care and custody of officers as the department of
- 11 corrections -shall-designate- DESIGNATES, and the expense of
- 12 guarding if guards are necessary shall be borne by the county.
- 13 Where IF 2 or more applications shall be ARE on file, they
- 14 shall be filled pro rata. All -moneys- MONEY collected under
- 15 the provisions of this section shall be turned over to the
- 16 state treasurer and credited to the general fund.
- 17 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless

 - of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
