

SENATE BILL No. 204

March 7, 1989, Introduced by Senators CARL, GEAKE, WELBORN, SHINKLE, CROPSEY, POSTHUMUS, SCHWARZ and FAUST and referred to the Committee on Economic Development.

A bill to amend section 8 of chapter VI of Act No. 3 of the Public Acts of 1895, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the incorporation of villages; to define their powers and duties; to provide for the levy and collection of taxes, borrowing of money, and issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness by villages; to define the powers and duties of the municipal finance commission or its successor agency and of the department of treasury with regard thereto; to define the application of this act and provide for its amendment by villages subject thereto; and to validate prior amendments and certain prior actions taken and bonds issued by villages,"

being section 66.8 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 8 of chapter VI of Act No. 3 of the
- 2 Public Acts of 1895, being section 66.8 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3 Laws, is amended to read as follows:

CHAPTER VI

2 Sec. 8. (1) Every village shall be allowed the use of the
3 jail of the county in which it is located, for the confinement of
4 all persons ~~liable~~ SENTENCED to imprisonment under ~~the~~
5 VILLAGE ordinances, ~~thereof,~~ or under any of the provisions of
6 this act; and the sheriff, or other keeper of ~~such~~ THE jail, ~~or~~
7 or other place of confinement or imprisonment, shall receive and
8 safely keep any person committed ~~thereto as aforesaid~~ TO
9 IMPRISONMENT AS DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION, until lawfully
10 discharged. In all cases of imprisonment for breaches of the
11 penal laws of this state, ~~such~~ THE COST OF receiving and keep-
12 ing A PERSON in ~~such~~ A jail OR OTHER PLACE OF CONFINEMENT OR
13 IMPRISONMENT shall be ~~at the expense of~~ PAID BY the county in
14 which the village is located, ~~;~~ AND in all other cases ~~it~~
15 shall be ~~at the expense of~~ PAID BY the village.

16 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "JAIL" INCLUDES A JAIL OPERATE
17 BY A PRIVATE ENTITY UNDER A CONTRACT WITH A COUNTY PURSUANT TO
18 THE ALTERNATIVE JAILS ACT.

19 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless

21 of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
