

# SENATE BILL No. 215

March 7, 1989, Introduced by Senators WELBORN, SHINKLE, GEAKE, CARL, BINSFELD, CROUSEY, POSTHUMUS, CRUCE, EHLERS, SCHWARZ and FAUST and referred to the Committee on Economic Development.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 7 of the Public Acts of 1981, entitled

"An act to prohibit without authorization the bringing into jails and other specified areas any alcoholic liquor, controlled substances, weapons, and certain other items; the selling or furnishing to prisoners, and the improper disposal of any alcoholic liquor, controlled substances, weapons, and certain other items; the possession or control by prisoners of any alcoholic liquor, controlled substances, weapons, and certain other items; to prescribe a penalty; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

as amended by Act No. 46 of the Public Acts of 1985, being section 801.261 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 7 of the Public Acts of  
2       1981, as amended by Act No. 46 of the Public Acts of 1985, being  
3       section 801.261 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read  
4       as follows:

1       Sec. 1. As used in this act:

2       (a) "Alcoholic liquor" means any spiritous, vinous, malt, or  
3       fermented liquor, liquid, or compound whether or not medicated,  
4       containing 1/2 of 1% or more of alcohol by volume and which is or  
5       readily can be made suitable as a beverage.

6       (b) "Controlled substance" means a drug, substance, or imme-  
7       diate precursor in schedules 1 to 5 of part 72 of Act No. 368 of  
8       the Public Acts of 1978, as amended, being sections 333.7201 to  
9       333.7231 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

10       (c) "Jail" means a municipal or county jail, work-camp,  
11       lockup, holding center, half-way house, community corrections  
12       center, house of correction, or any other facility maintained by  
13       a municipality or county, OR MAINTAINED BY A PRIVATE ENTITY UNDER  
14       CONTRACT WITH A MUNICIPALITY OR COUNTY PURSUANT TO THE ALTERNA-  
15       TIVE JAILS ACT, which houses prisoners.

16       (d) "Prisoner" means a person incarcerated in a jail or a  
17       person committed to a jail for incarceration who is a participant  
18       in a work release or vocational or educational study release  
19       program.

20       Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
