

# SENATE BILL No. 218

March 7, 1989, Introduced by Senators DE GROW, KELLY  
and NICHOLS and referred to the Committee on  
Government Operations.

A bill to amend section 3u of chapter 1 of the Revised  
Statutes of 1846, entitled  
"Of the statutes,"  
being section 8.3u of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 3u of chapter 1 of the Revised Statutes  
2 of 1846, being section 8.3u of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 3u. The provisions of any law or statute ~~which~~ THAT  
5 is re-enacted, amended, or revised, so far as ~~they~~ THE  
6 PROVISIONS are the same as those of prior laws, shall be con-  
7 strued as a continuation of ~~such~~ THE PRIOR laws and not as A  
8 new ~~enactments~~ ENACTMENT. If any provision of a law is  
9 repealed OR AMENDED and in substance re-enacted, a reference in

1 any other law to the repealed OR AMENDED provision shall be  
2 ~~deemed~~ CONSIDERED a reference to the re-enacted provision.

3 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
4 Senate Bill No. 95 of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
