

# SENATE BILL No. 243

March 9, 1989, Introduced by Senators EHLERS, ARTHURHULTZ, GAST, CHERRY and BINSFELD and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend section 21 of Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of 1851, entitled as amended

"An act to define the powers and duties of the county boards of commissioners of the several counties, and to confer upon them certain local, administrative and legislative powers; and to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act,"

being section 46.21 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to repeal certain parts of the act.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Section 21 of Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of  
2       1851, being section 46.21 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
3       amended to read as follows:

4       Sec. 21. ~~Every such board of supervisors shall have power~~  
5       ~~within their respective counties, to~~ A COUNTY BOARD OF  
6       COMMISSIONERS MAY permit or prohibit WITHIN THAT COUNTY the  
7       construction of any ~~dam or~~ bridge over or across any navigable

1 stream. They shall also have power to provide for the removal of  
2 any obstruction arising from the erection of booms or the col-  
3 lecting of logs or rafts in such streams, by any individual; and  
4 to direct the time in which, and places where, persons having  
5 logs, rafts and boats in such streams shall be allowed to remain,  
6 and when the ~~same~~ LOGS, RAFTS, AND BOATS shall be removed. →  
7 ~~and~~ A COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS may impose ~~such~~ ANY penal-  
8 ties as they ~~deem~~ CONSIDER necessary to enforce ~~such~~ regula-  
9 tions ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION, and MAY authorize the sheriffs  
10 or their deputies to carry into effect the regulations made under  
11 ~~the provisions of~~ this act.

12 Section 2. Section 22 of Act No. 156 of the Public Acts of  
13 1851, being section 46.22 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is  
14 repealed.

15 Section 3. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
16 Senate Bill No. 242  
17 of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.

18 Section 4. This amendatory act shall take effect January 1,  
19 1990.
