(5) Immediately above the place for signatures, on each part 2 of the petition shall be printed in 12-point type the following 3 warning:

4 WARNING

- Whoever knowingly signs this petition more than once, signs a name other than his OR HER own, signs when not a qualified and registered elector, or sets opposite his OR HER signature on a petition, a date other than the actual date <u>such</u> THE signature was affixed, is violating the provisions of this act.
- (6) The remainder of the petition form shall be as provided following the warning in section 544c. HOWEVER, EACH ELECTOR SHALL ALSO BE REQUIRED TO PRINT HIS OR HER NAME BESIDE HIS OR HER SIGNATURE ON THE PETITION. SPACE SHALL BE PROVIDED ON THE PETITION FOR THE PRINTED NAME.
