

SENATE BILL No. 381

April 27, 1989, Introduced by Senators EHLERS, CROPSEY,
DINGELL, GEO. HART and CHERRY and referred to the
Committee on Local Government and Veterans.

A bill to create the survey and remonumentation fund; and to
provide for its use.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. (1) The survey and remonumentation fund is created
2 in the state treasury as a separate fund, and shall be adminis-
3 tered and expended by the commission for the purposes of this
4 act. Money deposited in the fund, and all interest and earnings
5 generated by the fund, shall not lapse at the end of a fiscal
6 year, but shall remain in the fund to be expended as provided in
7 this act.

8 (2) A person who files with the county register of deeds any
9 instrument conveying an interest in real property shall pay to
10 the county register of deeds, at the time the instrument is
11 filed, a user fee of \$2.00. The fee required by this subsection
12 is in addition to any other fees or charges otherwise required by

1 law for the recording of instruments conveying an interest in
2 real property. Except as provided in subsection (3), the funds
3 received by a county under this subsection shall be remitted to
4 the state treasurer quarterly, and shall be deposited by the
5 state treasurer in the fund.

6 (3) A county may retain not more than 1-1/2% of the user
7 fees collected pursuant to subsection (2) to cover the costs of
8 administering this section.

9 (4) The fund may accept funds received as gifts or dona-
10 tions, or funds received from individuals or corporations to be
11 used as set forth in this act.

12 Sec. 2. This act shall not take effect unless Senate Bill

14 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
