## SENATE BILL No. 391

May 2, 1989, Introduced by Senators KELLY, DI NELLO, J. HART and FESSLER and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Affairs.

A bill to amend section 4 of Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the Extra Session of 1933, entitled as amended "The Michigan liquor control act," being section 436.4 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 4 of Act No. 8 of the Public Acts of the
- 2 Extra Session of 1933, being section 436.4 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 4. Exceptions to act. The provisions of this THIS
- 5 act <del>shall</del> DOES not <del>be construed to</del> prevent the ANY OF THE
- 6 FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) THE manufacture of cider from fruit, for the purpose of
- 8 making vinegar, and <del>non-intoxicating</del> NONINTOXICATING cider and
- 9 fruit juice for use and sale. -, and cider and CIDER OR fruit
- 10 juice shall be deemed non-intoxicating CONSIDERED

- 1 NONINTOXICATING within the meaning of this act when used -and/or-
- 2 OR sold within 30 days after -the- ITS manufacture. -thereof;
- 3 and this act shall not apply to wine
- 4 (B) WINE or cider of any alcoholic content made on the
- 5 premises by the owner or lessee of -such- THE premises, -provided
- 6 such IF THE premises are used and occupied by -such THE owner
- 7 or lessee as a dwelling and -such THE wine or cider is made for
- 8 family use and home consumption. -; or to-prevent the
- 9 (C) THE sale or gift, or keeping and storing for sale by
- 10 druggists, -and- general merchants, -and- OR others of any of the
- 11 medicinal preparations manufactured in accordance with the for-
- 12 mulas prescribed by the United States pharmacopoeia and national

- 14 fide medicinal and technical preparations, which contain no more
- 15 alcohol than is necessary to extract the medicinal properties of
- 16 the drugs contained in -such THE preparations; and no more alco-
- 17 hol than is necessary to hold the medicinal agents in solution
- 18 and to preserve the -same MEDICINAL AGENTS, which are manufac-
- 19 tured and sold as medicine and not as beverages, are unfit for
- 20 use for beverage purposes, and the sale of which does not now
- 21 require the payment of a United States liquor dealer's tax. -
- 22 or to prevent the
- 23 (D) THE manufacture and sale of tinctures or of toilet,
- 24 medicinal, and antiseptic preparations and solutions not intended
- 25 for internal human use nor to be sold as beverages, and which are
- 26 unfit for beverage purposes, and upon the outside of each bottle,
- 27 box, or package of which is printed in the English language,

- 1 conspicuously and legibly, the quantity by volume of alcohol in
- 2 -such THE preparations; or -to prevent the manufacture and
- 3 keeping for sale of the food product known as flavoring extracts
- 4 which shall be so manufactured and sold for cooking, culinary, or
- 5 flavoring purposes, and are unfit for use as a beverage or for
- 6 beverage purposes. -: Provided, That HOWEVER, it shall not be
- 7 lawful to manufacture or sell any toilet, medicinal, or antisep-
- 8 tic preparations or solutions, or any flavoring extracts or
- 9 patent or proprietary medicines or preparations, the manufacture
- 10 and sale of which now requires the payment of a United States
- 11 liquor dealer's tax, except as -herein provided -: Provided
- 12 further, That nothing in this act shall apply to the IN THIS
- 13 ACT.
- 14 (E) THE manufacture -and/or OR sale of ethyl, mechanical,
- 15 or industrial alcohol, not used for or made unfit for beverage
- 16 purposes. -: And provided further, That this act shall not
- 17 apply to the
- 18 (F) THE purchase of alcoholic liquor -as defined in this
- 19 act, for use in the manufacture of toilet, medicinal, or anti-
- 20 septic preparations or solutions, or any flavoring extract or
- 21 patent or proprietary medicines or preparations, by a manufac-
- 22 turer using -such THE alcoholic liquor exclusively for -such-
- 23 THOSE manufacturing purposes and duly licensed therefor by the
- 24 commission; -said WHICH license -to- SHALL expire on May -first
- 25 1 following the date of issuance, issued on the payment of an
- 26 annual fee of -10 dollars \$10.00 and the furnishing of -such A
- 27 bond or bonds as the commission may require running to the people

- 1 of the state of Michigan, for the faithful performance of the
- 2 conditions of the license and compliance with -the provisions of
- 3 this act.
- 4 (G) CONFECTIONERY CONTAINING LESS THAN 5% ALCOHOL BY WEIGHT.
- 5 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 6 Senate Bill No. 390 of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
