## SENATE BILL No. 450

May 11, 1989, Introduced by Senator CONROY and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend section 9621 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of 1978, entitled as amended "Public health code,"

being section 333.9621 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 9621 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1978, being section 333.9621 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 9621. A local health department, a state institution,
- 5 or a physician may require a microbiological examination and
- 6 analysis of blood, sputum, urine, water, milk, or other substance
- 7 from a locality where there is an outbreak of a communicable dis-
- 8 ease or epidemic requiring the examination or analysis to protect
- 9 the public health or for locating sources of infection. These
- 10 agencies may also require examination and analysis of public

- 1 water supplies and water used by the public to assure quality and
- 2 safety. These agencies shall forward or deliver to the depart-
- 3 ment a sample of the substance to be examined and analyzed in an
- 4 appropriate container, accompanied by a statement indicating the
- 5 examination and analyses requested. The examination and analyses
- 6 for these purposes shall be without charge. HOWEVER, THE DEPART-
- 7 MENT MAY CHARGE \$10.00 FOR EACH BACTERIOLOGICAL AND CHEMICAL
- 8 WATER TEST PERFORMED FOR A PRIVATE INDIVIDUAL.
