

SENATE BILL No. 450

May 11, 1989, Introduced by Senator CONROY and referred
to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental
Affairs.

A bill to amend section 9621 of Act No. 368 of the Public
Acts of 1978, entitled as amended
"Public health code,"
being section 333.9621 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 9621 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts
2 of 1978, being section 333.9621 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:
4 Sec. 9621. A local health department, a state institution,
5 or a physician may require a microbiological examination and
6 analysis of blood, sputum, urine, water, milk, or other substance
7 from a locality where there is an outbreak of a communicable dis-
8 ease or epidemic requiring the examination or analysis to protect
9 the public health or for locating sources of infection. These
10 agencies may also require examination and analysis of public

1 water supplies and water used by the public to assure quality and
2 safety. These agencies shall forward or deliver to the depart-
3 ment a sample of the substance to be examined and analyzed in an
4 appropriate container, accompanied by a statement indicating the
5 examination and analyses requested. The examination and analyses
6 for these purposes shall be without charge. HOWEVER, THE DEPART-
7 MENT MAY CHARGE \$10.00 FOR EACH BACTERIOLOGICAL AND CHEMICAL
8 WATER TEST PERFORMED FOR A PRIVATE INDIVIDUAL.
