

# SENATE BILL No. 454

May 16, 1989, Introduced by Senators EHLERS, BINSFELD, CHERRY and GAST and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend Act No. 106 of the Public Acts of 1963,  
entitled

"An act to define, control and prohibit the littering of public and private property and waters; to prescribe penalties for violation of this act; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

as amended, being sections 752.901 to 752.906 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 1b.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Act No. 106 of the Public Acts of 1963, as  
2 amended, being sections 752.901 to 752.906 of the Michigan  
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1b to read as  
4 follows:

5       SEC. 1B. (1) UNLESS IN COMPLIANCE WITH STATE OR FEDERAL LAW  
6 OR A PERMIT ISSUED UNDER AN APPLICABLE STATE OR FEDERAL LAW, A  
7 PERSON SHALL NOT DISPOSE, DUMP, OR PLACE OIL OR OTHER LIQUIDS

1 THAT ARE OR MAY BECOME DETRIMENTAL TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY,  
2 WELFARE, OR TO THE ENVIRONMENT ON THE GROUND OR INTO THE WATERS  
3 OF THIS STATE.

4 (2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDE-  
5 MEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR 90 DAYS, OR A FINE OF NOT  
6 MORE THAN \$1,000.00, OR BOTH. IN PLACE OF A SENTENCE PROVIDED IN  
7 THIS SUBSECTION, THE COURT MAY ORDER THAT THE DEFENDANT ENGAGE IN  
8 RECYCLING-RELATED LABOR FOR A NUMBER OF HOURS DETERMINED BY THE  
9 COURT, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, OIL RECYCLING, UNDER THE  
10 SUPERVISION OF THE COURT. A VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION BY A  
11 PERSON, OTHER THAN AN INDIVIDUAL, IS PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF NOT  
12 MORE THAN \$2,500.00.

13 (3) NOTHING IN THIS SECTION PROHIBITS ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS  
14 UNDER OTHER STATE OR FEDERAL LAWS APPLICABLE TO AN ACTIVITY  
15 DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION.

16 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "PERSON" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL,  
17 PARTNERSHIP, ASSOCIATION, CORPORATION, OR ANY OTHER LEGAL ENTITY.
