- 4 SEC. 437. (1) EFFECTIVE FOR THE TAX YEAR BEGINNING
- 5 JANUARY 1, 1990 AND UNTIL THE STATE TREASURER CERTIFIES THAT THE
- 6 ASSETS IN THE MICHIGAN ORGAN TRANSPLANT FUND EXCEED
- 7 \$20,000,000.00, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ENTITLED TO A TAX REFUND
- 8 UNDER THIS ACT SUFFICIENT TO MAKE A DESIGNATION UNDER THIS

 SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE MICHIGAN ORGAN TRANSPLANT FUND.

of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
