

# SENATE BILL No. 462

May 18, 1989, Introduced by Senators DI NELLO, SCHWARZ, DE GROW, EHLERS, POSTHUMUS, CARL, POLLACK, SEDERBURG, GAST, KELLY, DINGELL, BARCIA, CROPSEY and O'BRIEN and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill to amend Act No. 281 of the Public Acts of 1967, entitled  
"Income tax act of 1967,"  
as amended, being sections 206.1 to 206.532 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 437.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1           Section 1. Act No. 281 of the Public Acts of 1967, as  
2           amended, being sections 206.1 to 206.532 of the Michigan Compiled  
3           Laws, is amended by adding section 437 to read as follows:  
4           SEC. 437. (1) EFFECTIVE FOR THE TAX YEAR BEGINNING  
5           JANUARY 1, 1990 AND UNTIL THE STATE TREASURER CERTIFIES THAT THE  
6           ASSETS IN THE MICHIGAN ORGAN TRANSPLANT FUND EXCEED  
7           \$20,000,000.00, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS ENTITLED TO A TAX REFUND  
8           UNDER THIS ACT SUFFICIENT TO MAKE A DESIGNATION UNDER THIS

1 SECTION MAY DESIGNATE THAT \$2.00 OR MORE OF HIS OR HER REFUND BE  
2 CREDITED TO THE MICHIGAN ORGAN TRANSPLANT FUND.

3 (2) THE TAX DESIGNATION AUTHORIZED IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE  
4 CLEARLY AND UNAMBIGUOUSLY PRINTED ON THE FIRST PAGE OF THE STATE  
5 INDIVIDUAL INCOME TAX RETURN.

6 (3) NOTWITHSTANDING THE OTHER ALLOCATIONS AND DISBURSEMENTS  
7 REQUIRED UNDER THIS ACT, AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE CUMULATIVE DESIG-  
8 NATIONS MADE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE  
9 MICHIGAN ORGAN TRANSPLANT FUND CREATED UNDER SECTION 10110 OF THE  
10 PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, ACT NO. 368 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1978, BEING  
11 SECTION 333.10110 OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED LAWS, AND APPROPRIATED  
12 SOLELY FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE MICHIGAN ORGAN TRANSPLANT FUND.

13 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
14 Senate Bill No. 461  
15 of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
