

# SENATE BILL No. 471

May 18, 1989, Introduced by Senators ENGLER, KELLY, ARTHURHULTZ, MILLER, IRWIN, GEAKE, POLLACK, CARL, SEDERBURG, GAST, DI NELLO, DINGELL, BINSFELD, BARCIA, MACK, SCHWARZ, WELBORN, DE GROW, CROUSEY, N. SMITH, FESSLER, CRUCE, SHINKLE, POSTHUMUS, FAUST, NICHOLS, CONROY and O'BRIEN and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, entitled "The Michigan penal code," as amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 520m.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, as  
2 amended, being sections 750.1 to 750.568 of the Michigan Compiled  
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 520m to read as follows:  
4 SEC. 520M. A PERSON CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF SECTION  
5 520B, 520C, 520D, 520F, OR 520G SHALL PROVIDE SAMPLES OF HIS OR  
6 HER BLOOD FOR CHEMICAL TESTING FOR A DETERMINATION OF THE BLOOD'S  
7 GENETIC MARKERS AND SHALL PROVIDE SAMPLES OF HIS OR HER SALIVA  
8 FOR CHEMICAL TESTING FOR A DETERMINATION OF THE SECRETOR STATUS  
9 OF THE SALIVA. THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE

1 INVESTIGATION OF THE OFFENSE FOR WHICH THE PERSON IS CONVICTED  
2 SHALL PROVIDE FOR THE SAMPLES TO BE TAKEN IN A MEDICALLY APPROVED  
3 MANNER BY QUALIFIED PERSONS USING BLOOD SPECIMEN VIALS AND OTHER  
4 SUPPLIES PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE, AND SHALL  
5 FORWARD THE SAMPLES TO THE DEPARTMENT, AS REQUIRED UNDER RULES  
6 PROMULGATED PURSUANT TO THE DNA IDENTIFICATION PROFILING SYSTEM  
7 ACT.

8 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless  
9 Senate Bill No. 469  
10 of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
