- 3 Laws, is amended by adding section 33 to read as follows:
- 4 SEC. 33. THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS BY RESOLUTION
- 5 MAY SUBMIT TO THE ELECTORS OF THE COUNTY FOR AN ADVISORY VOTE AT
- 6 A GENERAL OR SPECIAL ELECTION ANY ACTION THAT THE BOARD HAS

1 AUTHORITY TO TAKE. IN THE RESOLUTION, THE BOARD SHALL SPECIFY

2 THE DATE OF THE ELECTION.
