SENATE BILL No. 505

June 28, 1989, Introduced by Senator CRUCE and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill to create the drug abuse prevention and education fund; to provide for expenditures from the fund; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies and departments.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "drug abuse prevention and education act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "Department" means the department of education.
- 5 (b) "Fund" means the drug abuse prevention and education
- 6 fund created in section 3.
- 7 (c) "Intermediate district" means that term as defined in
- 8 section 4 of the school code of 1976, Act No. 451 of the Public
- 9 Acts of 1976, being section 380.4 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

- 1 Sec. 3. The drug abuse prevention and education fund is
- 2 created as a separate fund in the state treasury. The fund shall
- 3 be expended only as provided in this act. The state treasurer
- 4 shall credit to the fund all amounts received under section 7524
- 5 of the public health code, Act No. 368 of the Public Acts of
- 6 1978, being section 333.7524 of the Michigan Compiled Laws. The
- 7 state treasurer shall invest fund money in the same manner as
- 8 surplus funds are invested under section 143 of Act No. 105 of
- 9 the Public Acts of 1855, being section 21.143 of the Michigan
- 10 Compiled Laws. Earnings from the fund shall be credited to the
- 11 fund.
- 12 Sec. 4. (1) Before July 31 of each year, the department
- 13 shall direct and authorize the state treasurer in writing to dis-
- 14 burse money from the fund to intermediate districts as provided
- 15 under section 5.
- 16 (2) An intermediate district that receives a disbursement
- 17 under this section shall distribute the disbursement to elemen-
- 18 tary and secondary schools within that intermediate district as
- 19 directed by the department.
- 20 (3) An elementary or secondary school that receives a dis-
- 21 bursement under this section shall only use that disbursement to
- 22 pay for the drug prevention and education programs of that
- 23 school.
- 24 (4) A disbursement under this act shall be used to enhance
- 25 and increase revenue for drug prevention and education programs,
- 26 and not to supplant local, federal, or other state funds that, in
- 27 the absence of a disbursement under this act, are available for

- 1 providing drug prevention and education programs in elementary
- 2 and secondary schools.
- 3 Sec. 5. (1) The department shall distribute 50% of the fund
- 4 to intermediate districts on an equal per pupil basis.
- 5 (2) After making the distributions required under subsection
- 6 (1), the department shall distribute to each intermediate dis-
- 7 trict a percentage of the fund equal to the percentage of the
- 8 money credited to the fund from drug forfeitures by police agen-
- 9 cies within that intermediate district. If a police agency has
- 10 jurisdiction extending into 2 or more intermediate districts, the
- 11 department shall distribute money under this subsection to each
- 12 of those intermediate districts based upon the proportional geo-
- 13 graphical area of jurisdiction of that police agency in each of
- 14 those intermediate districts.
- 15 Sec. 6. The department shall promulgate rules to implement
- 16 this act.
- 17 Sec. 7. This act shall not take effect unless Senate Bill
