A bill to require the inclusion of certain statements in lease contracts involving motor vehicles.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Lease contract" means a contract for or in contempla-
- 3 tion of the lease for the use of a motor vehicle and for services
- 4 incidental to the lease of that motor vehicle by a person for a
- 5 term exceeding 120 days.
- 6 (b) "Lessee" means a person who leases, offers to lease, or
- 7 is offered the lease of a motor vehicle under a lease contract.
- 8 (c) "Lessor" means a person who is engaged in the business
- 9 of leasing, offering to lease, or arranging the lease of a motor
- 10 vehicle under a lease contract.

- (d) "Motor vehicle" means a vehicle which is self-propelled
- 2 and which is primarily intended for the transport of persons,
- 3 including passenger vans and minivans.
- 4 Sec. 2. (1) A lease contract involving a motor vehicle
- 5 shall contain a specific statement in a separate paragraph advis-
- 6 ing the lessee that the residual value of the motor vehicle as
- 7 determined by the lessor may be different than the insured value
- 8 of the motor vehicle as determined by the insurer of the
- 9 vehicle.
- 10 (2) If upon the destruction, theft, or loss of a leased
- 11 motor vehicle the lessee is required to pay the difference
- 12 between the residual value and the insured value to the lessor, a
- 13 specific statement explaining this fact shall be included in the
- 14 lease contract immediately after the statement required by
- 15 subsection (1) with a line on which the lessee shall sign indi-
- 16 cating that he or she has read this statement and understands its
- 17 content.
