

# SENATE BILL No. 511

July 12, 1989, Introduced by Senator MACK and referred  
to the Committee on State Affairs, Tourism, and  
Transportation.

A bill to amend Act No. 74 of the Public Acts of 1968, entitled as amended

"An act to register and regulate snowmobiles; to provide for education and training programs; to provide for trails, areas, and facilities; to create a recreational snowmobile trail improvement fund; to provide for expenditure of appropriations; and to prescribe penalties,"

as amended, being sections 257.1501 to 257.1518 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 4f.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Act No. 74 of the Public Acts of 1968, as  
2       amended, being sections 257.1501 to 257.1518 of the Michigan  
3       Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 4f to read as  
4       follows:

5       SEC. 4F. (1) THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL  
6       CREATE AND MAINTAIN A SET OF SNOWMOBILE TRAIL MAPS, 1 OF WHICH

1 SHALL BE FOR THE UPPER PENINSULA AND 1 OF WHICH SHALL BE FOR THE  
2 LOWER PENINSULA.

3 (2) THE MAPS SHALL BE COLOR CODED WITH STATE TRAILS IN 1  
4 COLOR AND TRAILS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY IN A DIFFERENT COLOR.

5 (3) EACH MAP SHALL INDICATE THE LOCATION ALONG EACH TRAIL OF  
6 PLACES WHERE FOOD AND BEVERAGES MAY BE OBTAINED, THE DISTANCES  
7 BETWEEN THOSE LOCATIONS, AND ANY LOCATIONS WHERE TRAILS INTERSECT  
8 WITH STATE TRUNKLINE HIGHWAYS, COUNTY ROADS, OR CITY AND VILLAGE  
9 STREETS.

10 (4) THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL FURNISH APPRO-  
11 PRIATE SIGNS ON STATE TRAILS. THE OWNERS OF LANDS ALONG PRIVATE  
12 TRAILS MAY POST APPROPRIATE SIGNS ON THOSE TRAILS.
