- 1 SHALL BE FOR THE UPPER PENINSULA AND 1 OF WHICH SHALL BE FOR THE

- 3 (2) THE MAPS SHALL BE COLOR CODED WITH STATE TRAILS IN 1
- 4 COLOR AND TRAILS ON PRIVATE PROPERTY IN A DIFFERENT COLOR.
- 5 (3) EACH MAP SHALL INDICATE THE LOCATION ALONG EACH TRAIL OF
- 6 PLACES WHERE FOOD AND BEVERAGES MAY BE OBTAINED, THE DISTANCES
- 7 BETWEEN THOSE LOCATIONS, AND ANY LOCATIONS WHERE TRAILS INTERSECT
