SENATE BILL No. 516

July 13, 1989, Introduced by Senator CONROY and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend sections 495, 500a, 506a, and 523 of Act No. 116 of the Public Acts of 1954, entitled "Michigan election law,"

sections 495, 500a, and 523 as amended and section 506a as added by Act No. 275 of the Public Acts of 1988, being sections 168.495, 168.500a, 168.506a, and 168.523 of the Michigan Compiled Laws; and to add section 506b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Sections 495, 500a, 506a, and 523 of Act No. 116
- 2 of the Public Acts of 1954, sections 495, 500a, and 523 as
- 3 amended and section 506a as added by Act No. 275 of the Public
- 4 Acts of 1988, being sections 168.495, 168.500a, 168.506a, and
- 5 168.523 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, are amended and section
- 6 506b is added to read as follows:

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- 1 Sec. 495. (1) The registration affidavit required under 2 section 493 shall contain all of the following:
- 3 (a) The name of the elector.
- 4 (b) The residence address OF THE ELECTOR, INCLUDING THE
 5 street and number or rural route and box number, if any. —, of
 6 the elector.
- 7 (c) The birthplace and birth date of the elector.
- 8 (d) The driver's license or state personal identification9 card number of the elector, if available.
- (e) A statement that the elector is a citizen of the United
 11 States.
- (f) A statement that the elector is at the time of complet-13 ing the affidavit, or will be on the date of the next election, 14 not less than 18 years of age.
- (g) A statement that the elector has or will have lived in this state not less than 30 days before the next election.
- (h) A statement that the elector has or will have established his or her residence in the township, city, or village in the which the elector is applying for registration not less than 30 days before the next election.
- 21 (i) A statement that the elector is or will be a qualified 22 elector of the township, city, or village on the date of the next 23 election.
- 24 (j) A space in which the elector shall state the place of 25 the elector's last registration, IF ANY.

- (k) For the purpose of voting in a presidential primary2 election, a space for the elector to declare a party preference3 or that the elector has no party preference.
- 4 (2) Until February 15, 1992, the secretary of state or the 5 secretary of state's agent shall print a notice that shall be 6 provided to each person applying for registration. The notice 7 shall contain all of the following information:
- 8 (a) That, for the purpose of voting in a presidential pri-9 mary election, the elector must declare a party preference.
- (b) That, if the elector prefers to register with no party

 11 preference, the elector is not eligible to vote in a presidential

 12 primary election unless the elector declares a party preference

 13 at least 30 days before the presidential primary election TO

 14 THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK BEFORE THE DAY OF THE PRESIDENTIAL

 15 PRIMARY ELECTION OR TO AN ELECTION OFFICIAL AT THE POLLS IN THAT

 16 PERSON'S PRECINCT ON PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION DAY.
- (c) That, even if currently registered to vote, the elector is not eligible to vote in a presidential primary election unless the elector declares —in writing to the city or township clerk a party preference at least 30 days before the presidential primary election—A PARTY PREFERENCE TO THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK BEFORE THE DAY OF THE PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION OR TO AN ELECTION OF TO AN ELECTION PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION OR TO PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION DAY.
- (d) That, if the elector declares a party preference or declares that the elector has no party preference, that declaration of preference remains as that elector's

- 2 party preference or declares that he or she has no party prefer-
- 3 ence on a form prescribed by the secretary of state or in writing
- 4 to the city or township clerk IT BY APPLICATION TO THE CITY OR

- 6 TION OR TO AN ELECTION OFFICIAL AT THE POLLS IN THAT PERSON'S
- 7 PRECINCT ON PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION DAY.
- 8 (3) Until February 15, 1992, the city or township clerk
- 9 shall provide each elector who votes in an election in that city
- 10 or township the notice required under subsection (2) on a form
- 11 prescribed by the secretary of state on which an elector may
- 12 declare his or her party preference or that the elector has no
- 13 party preference for the purpose of voting in a presidential pri-
- 14 mary election.
- 15 (4) The secretary of state shall provide to each county
- 16 clerk for distribution to the city and township clerks in the
- 17 county a sufficient number of the notices required for distribu-
- 18 tion to electors under subsections (2) and (3).
- 19 Sec. 500a. (1) The secretary of state or the secretary of
- 20 state's agent shall afford a person who appears in a department
- 21 of state branch office or , beginning March 1, 1989, a person
- 22 who applies for renewal of an operator's or chauffeur's license
- 23 under section 307 of the Michigan vehicle code, Act No. 300 of
- 24 the Public Acts of 1949, being section 257.307 of the Michigan
- 25 Compiled Laws, an opportunity to complete an application to req-
- 26 ister to vote or to change the person's voting registration name,
- 27 address, or, for the purpose of voting in a presidential primary

- 1 election, party preference, if the applicant possesses the
- 2 qualifications of an elector on the date of application or will
- 3 possess the qualifications at the next election. This subsection
- 4 -shall not be construed to DOES NOT require a registered elector
- 5 to periodically reregister or to renew his or her registration.
- 6 The application for registration made under this section shall
- 7 contain all of the following:
- 8 (a) The name of the applicant.
- 9 (b) The residence address of the applicant including street
- 10 and number or rural route and box number, if any.
- (c) The city or township and county of residence of the
- 12 applicant, and the school district of the applicant if known.
- (d) The date of BIRTHPLACE AND birth DATE of the
- 14 applicant.
- 15 (e) The birthplace of the applicant.
- 16 (E) -(f) The driver's license or state personal identifica-
- 17 tion card number of the applicant, if available.
- (F) $\frac{-(g)}{-(g)}$ A statement that the applicant has the qualifica-
- 19 tions of an elector as of the date of applying for registration,
- 20 or will have the qualifications of an elector at the next
- 21 election.
- 22 (G) (h) A space for the applicant to declare, for the pur-
- 23 pose of voting in a presidential primary election, a party pref-
- 24 erence or that the applicant has no party preference.
- 25 (H) -(i) A statement that the registration is not effective
- 26 until processed by the clerk of the city or township in which the
- 27 applicant resides.

- (I) (j) A statement that the applicant, if qualified, may
 vote at an election occurring not less than 30 days after the
 date of completing the application.
- 4 (J) -(k) A space to indicate the applicant's last place of 5 registration, IF ANY.
- 6 (K) -(2) A statement authorizing the cancellation of regis-7 tration at the applicant's last place of registration.
- 8 (1) (m) A space for the applicant to sign and certify to9 the truth of the statements on the application.
- (2) The applicant shall sign the application. Upon receipt of the application, the agent shall sign the application, stamp the application with a validation stamp, and provide the applicant applicant with a receipt verifying the registration application. The agent shall promptly forward the application to the county clerk of the applicant's residence or to a city or township clerk designated by the secretary of state.

 18 secretary of state's agent shall provide along with the applica19 tion to register to vote or to change a registration under sub20 section (1) a notice that contains all of the following

- 5 vote, the elector is not eligible to vote in a presidential pri-
- 6 mary election unless the elector declares in writing to the city
- 7 or township clerk a party preference at least 30 days before the
- 8 presidential primary election A PARTY PREFERENCE TO THE CITY OR
- 9 TOWNSHIP CLERK BEFORE THE DAY OF THE PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELEC-
- 10 TION OR TO AN ELECTION OFFICIAL AT THE POLLS IN THAT PERSON'S
- 11 PRECINCT ON PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION DAY.
- (d) That, if the elector declares a party preference or
- 13 declares that the elector has no party preference, that declara-
- 14 tion -of preference- remains as that elector's -preference-
- 15 DECLARATION until the elector changes -his or her party prefer
- 16 ence or declares that he or she has no party preference on a form
- 17 prescribed by the secretary of state or in writing to the city or
- 18 township clerk IT BY APPLICATION TO THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK
- 19 BEFORE THE DAY OF THE PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION OR TO AN
- 20 ELECTION OFFICIAL AT THE POLLS IN THAT PERSON'S PRECINCT ON PRES-
- 21 IDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION DAY.
- Sec. 506a. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a reg-
- 23 istered elector of a city or township may declare or change his
- 24 or her party preference or declare that he or she has no party
- 25 preference for the purpose of voting in a presidential primary
- 26 election by applying in person with the city or township clerk ON
- 27 A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE or by sending to the

- 1 city or township a signed written request that includes the
 2 following information:
- 3 (a) The elector's name.
- 4 (b) The elector's address.
- 5 (c) The elector's -date of birth DATE.
- 6 (d) The elector's party preference or that the elector has
 7 no party preference.
- 8 (e) The elector's signature.
- 9 (2) If the elector fails to include his or her date of
 10 birth DATE in the written request under subsection (1), the city
 11 or township clerk shall record the elector's party preference or
 12 declaration of no party preference if the clerk can otherwise
 13 determine the elector's identity under subsection (3).

- 1 THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S AGENT OR THE COUNTY CLERK before -a-
- 2 presidential primary election DAY, THEN THE DECLARATION OR CHANGE
- 3 OF PARTY PREFERENCE OR DECLARATION OF NO PARTY PREFERENCE is
- 4 -not effective for that election. -However, if the thirtieth
- 5 day before a presidential primary election falls on a Saturday,
- 6 Sunday, or legal holiday, the city or township clerk shall accept
- 7 applications to change party preference or to declare no party
- 8 preference the next business day.
- 9 (4) The city or township clerk shall mail to the elector a
- 10 corrected voter identification card as required in section 499,
- 11 to inform the elector of the DECLARATION OR change of party pref-
- 12 erence or declaration of no party preference.
- 13 SEC. 506B. (1) A REGISTERED ELECTOR OF A CITY OR TOWNSHIP
- 14 MAY DECLARE OR CHANGE HIS OR HER PARTY PREFERENCE OR DECLARE THAT
- 15 HE OR SHE HAS NO PARTY PREFERENCE FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING IN A
- 16 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION BY APPLYING IN PERSON WITH AN ELEC-
- 17 TION OFFICIAL AT THE POLLS IN THAT PERSON'S PRECINCT ON PRESIDEN-
- 18 TIAL PRIMARY ELECTION DAY ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY
- 19 OF STATE.
- 20 (2) UPON RECEIPT OF A COMPLETED FORM UNDER SUBSECTION (1),
- 21 THE ELECTION OFFICIAL SHALL COMPARE IDENTIFYING INFORMATION PRO-
- 22 VIDED BY THE APPLICANT WITH INFORMATION ON THE VOTER REGISTRATION
- 23 CARDS OR VOTER REGISTRATION LIST IN THE MANNER SET FORTH IN
- 24 SECTION 523. IF THE IDENTIFYING INFORMATION CORRESPONDS, THE
- 25 ELECTION OFFICIAL SHALL WRITE HIS OR HER INITIALS ON THE FORM AND
- 26 FORWARD IT TO THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK. THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP
- 27 CLERK SHALL STRIKE THROUGH THE LAST PARTY PREFERENCE OR

- 1 DECLARATION OF NO PARTY PREFERENCE, IF ANY, AND RECORD THE
- 2 ELECTOR'S NEW PARTY PREFERENCE OR DECLARATION OF NO PARTY PREFER-
- 3 ENCE ON THE ORIGINAL AND DUPLICATE REGISTRATION CARDS IN A MANNER
- 4 PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE.
- 5 (3) THE CITY OR TOWNSHIP CLERK SHALL MAIL TO THE ELECTOR A
- 6 CORRECTED VOTER IDENTIFICATION CARD AS REQUIRED IN SECTION 499,
- 7 TO INFORM THE ELECTOR OF THE DECLARATION OR CHANGE OF PARTY PREF-
- 8 ERENCE OR DECLARATION OF NO PARTY PREFERENCE.
- 9 Sec. 523. (1) At each election, before being given a
- 10 ballot, each registered elector offering to vote shall identify
- 11 himself or herself by executing an application showing his or her
- 12 signature or mark and address of residence in the presence of an
- 13 election official. If the voter registration cards are used in
- 14 the precinct, the election official in charge of the precinct
- 15 registration file shall compare the signature upon the applica-
- 16 tion with the signature upon the registration card. If voter
- 17 registration lists are used in the precinct, the election inspec-
- 18 tor shall determine if the name on the application to vote
- 19 appears on the voter registration list. If the name appears on
- 20 the voter registration list, the elector shall provide further
- 21 identification by giving his or her date of birth or other infor-
- 22 mation stated upon the voter registration list. In -precincts- A
- 23 PRECINCT using A voter registration -lists LIST, the date of
- 24 birth may be required to be placed on the application to vote.
- 25 If the signature or an item of information does not correspond,
- 26 the vote of the person shall be challenged, and the same
- 27 procedure shall be followed as provided in this act for the

- I challenging of an elector. If the person offering to vote has
- 2 signed the registration card or application by making a mark, the
- 3 person shall identify himself or herself by giving his or her
- 4 date of birth, which shall be compared with the date of birth
- 5 stated upon the registration card or voter registration list, or
- 6 shall give other identification as may be referred to upon the
- 7 registration card or voter registration list.
- 8 (2) If, upon a comparison of the signature or other identi-
- 9 fication, it is found that the applicant is entitled to vote, the
- 10 election officer having charge of the registration list shall
- 11 approve the application and write his or her initials on the
- 12 application, after which the number on the ballot issued shall be
- 13 noted on the application. The application shall serve as 1 of
- 14 the 2 poll lists required to be kept as a record of a person who
- 15 has voted. The application shall be filed with the township,
- 16 city, or village clerk. If voter registration cards are used in
- 17 the precinct, the date of the election shall be noted by 1 of the
- 18 election officials upon the precinct registration card of each
- 19 elector voting at an election. If A voter registration -lists
- 20 are LIST IS used in the precinct, the election official shall
- 21 clearly indicate upon the list each elector voting at that
- 22 election. The clerk of a city, village, or township shall main-
- 23 tain a record of voting participation for each registered
- 24 elector.
- 25 (3) In addition to the requirements of subsection (1),
- 26 UNLESS AN ELECTOR COMPLETES A FORM UNDER SECTION 506B, the
- 27 election official in a presidential primary election shall only

- 1 allow an elector to vote the presidential primary ballot of the
- 2 party preference shown on the precinct registration file of that
- 3 elector under section 495a. If an elector is registered with no
- 4 party preference shown on the precinct registration file of that
- 5 elector, the elector shall not be allowed to vote a presidential
- 6 primary ballot. IF AN ELECTOR COMPLETES A FORM UNDER
- 7 SECTION 506B, THE ELECTION OFFICIAL SHALL ONLY ALLOW THE ELECTOR
- 8 TO VOTE THE PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY BALLOT OF THE PARTY PREFERENCE
- 9 SHOWN ON THE FORM. IF NO PARTY PREFERENCE IS SHOWN ON THE FORM,
- 10 THE ELECTOR SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED TO VOTE A PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY
- 11 BALLOT.
- 12 (4) The record maintained by the clerk of a city or township
- 13 under subsection (2) shall contain the name of the party ballot
- 14 voted under subsection (3) by the elector at the presidential
- 15 primary election.

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
