

# SENATE BILL No. 528

July 26, 1989, Introduced by Senator WELBORN and referred  
to the Committee on Local Government and Veterans.

A bill to amend section 2 of chapter VI of Act No. 3 of the  
Public Acts of 1895, entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the incorporation of villages; to define their powers and duties; to provide for the levy and collection of taxes, borrowing of money, and issuance of bonds and other evidences of indebtedness by villages; to define the powers and duties of the municipal finance commission or its successor agency and of the department of treasury with regard thereto; to define the application of this act and provide for its amendment by villages subject thereto; and to validate prior amendments and certain prior actions taken and bonds issued by villages,"

being section 66.2 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1       Section 1. Section 2 of chapter VI of Act No. 3 of the
- 2       Public Acts of 1895, being section 66.2 of the Michigan Compiled
- 3       Laws, is amended to read as follows:

## CHAPTER VI

1

2       Sec. 2. Except as otherwise ~~specifically~~ provided in this  
3 act, the council of a village authorized to pass an ordinance ~~,~~  
4 may prescribe a penalty for a violation of the ordinance. If a  
5 penalty is prescribed, ~~it~~ THE PENALTY shall be prescribed in  
6 the ordinance. The ordinance may provide that a person who vio-  
7 lates the ordinance ~~may~~ IS SUBJECT TO EITHER, OR BOTH, OF THE  
8 FOLLOWING:

9       (a) ~~Be punished~~ PUNISHMENT by imprisonment for not more  
10 than ~~90~~ 180 days, or BY a fine of not more than \$500.00, or  
11 both.

12       (b) ~~Be ordered to pay~~ PAYMENT OF court costs.
