THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Section 1. Section 16181 of Act No. 368 of the Public Acts
- 2 of 1978, as amended by Act No. 174 of the Public Acts of 1986,
- 3 being section 333.16181 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 16181. A board may grant a nonrenewable, temporary
- 6 license to an applicant who has completed all requirements for
- 7 licensure except for examination or other required evaluation
- 8 procedure. A person WHO HAS PREVIOUSLY FAILED THE EXAMINATION OR
- 9 OTHER REQUIRED EVALUATION PROCEDURE OR whose license has been

- 1 suspended or revoked shall not be issued a temporary license. A
- 2 temporary license issued pursuant to this section is valid for 1
- 3 year, until the results of the next scheduled examination are
- 4 available or the results of the next required evaluation proce-
- 5 dure are available and a reasonable time elapses for issuance of
- 6 the certificate of licensure; or until the examination date, if
- 7 the applicant does not take the examination; whichever is
- 8 soonest BUT SHALL AUTOMATICALLY BE REVOKED IF THE APPLICANT
- 9 FAILS THE EXAMINATION OR OTHER REQUIRED EVALUATION PROCEDURE.
- 10 THE HOLDER OF A TEMPORARY LICENSE SHALL PRACTICE ONLY UNDER THE

- 12 THIS ARTICLE. The department shall promptly issue a temporary
