

SENATE BILL No. 606

October 17, 1989, Introduced by Senators O'BRIEN, FAUST, J. HART, CROPSEY, SEDERBURG, SCHWARZ, POSTHUMUS and CHERRY and referred to the Committee on Local Government and Veterans.

A bill to amend section 1 of Act No. 161 of the Public Acts of 1895, entitled

"An act to require county treasurers to furnish transcripts and abstracts of records, and fixing the fees to be paid therefor," as amended by Act No. 291 of the Public Acts of 1984, being section 48.101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 1 of Act No. 161 of the Public Acts of
2 1895, as amended by Act No. 291 of the Public Acts of 1984, being
3 section 48.101 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is amended to read
4 as follows:

5 Sec. 1. (1) A county treasurer shall make upon request a
6 transcript of any paper or record on file in the treasurer's
7 office for the following fees:

1 (a) For an abstract of taxes on any description of land,
2 ~~25~~ 50 cents for each year covered by the abstract.

3 (b) For an abstract with statement of name and residence of
4 taxpayers, ~~25~~ 50 cents per year for each description of land
5 covered by the abstract.

6 (c) For A list of state tax lands or state bids, ~~25~~ 50
7 cents for each description of land on the list.

8 (d) For 1 copy of any paper or document, ~~at the rate of 25~~
9 50 cents per 100 words.

10 (e) For each certificate, ~~25~~ 50 cents.

11 (2) For statements in respect to the payment of taxes
12 required by section 135 of the general property tax act, Act
13 No. 206 of the Public Acts of 1893, as amended, being section
14 211.135 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, the county treasurer shall
15 receive ~~20~~ 50 cents for each description of land contained in
16 the certificate, but the total amount paid shall not be less than
17 ~~\$1.00~~ \$2.00.

18 (3) ~~In no case shall any~~ AN abstract, list, copy, or
19 statement made as required by this act ~~—~~ SHALL be furnished for
20 ~~a sum~~ NOT less than ~~50 cents~~ \$1.00.

21 (4) All ~~moneys~~ MONEY collected under the provisions of
22 this act shall be retained by the county treasurer collecting
23 ~~the same~~ IT, except in ~~counties~~ A COUNTY in which the county
24 treasurer receives a salary in lieu of all fees. ~~—, in which~~
25 ~~counties such moneys shall be placed, by the treasurers collect-~~
26 ~~ing the same,~~ IN SUCH A COUNTY, THE MONEY SHALL BE DEPOSITED BY

1 THE TREASURER COLLECTING IT to the credit of the general fund of
2 the county.

3 (5) A charter county with a population of more than
4 2,000,000 may impose by ordinance a different amount for the fees
5 prescribed by this section ~~—A charter county—~~ BUT shall not
6 impose a fee ~~—which—~~ THAT is greater than the cost of the service
7 for which the fee is charged.
