- 1 (B) IF THE VACANCY IS IN THE OFFICE OF PROSECUTING ATTORNEY,
- 2 IT SHALL BE FILLED BY APPOINTMENT BY THE JUDGE OR JUDGES OF THAT
- 3 JUDICIAL CIRCUIT AND OF THE RECORDER'S COURT OF EACH CITY IN THAT
- 4 COUNTY HAVING A RECORDER'S COURT.
