

SENATE BILL No. 636

October 25, 1989, Introduced by Senators CROPSEY, DE GROW,
GAST, WELBORN, BARCIA, POSTHUMUS, DI NELLO, DILLINGHAM
and J. HART and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend section 301 of Act No. 160 of the Public

Acts of 1989, entitled

"An act to make appropriations for various state departments and agencies, community and junior colleges, state institutions of higher education, the legislature, and the judicial branch for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1989; to create certain funds; to require reports; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.".

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 301 of Act No. 160 of the Public Acts of
2 1989 is amended to read as follows:

3 AGRICULTURE

4 Sec. 301. The \$100,000.00 to be used for ~~the attraction,~~
5 ~~enhancement, or completion of ethanol producing facilities that~~
6 ~~use Michigan produced corn in the production of their product~~
7 RESEARCH OF CHEMICALS DERIVED FROM CORN GROWN IN THIS STATE FOR,
8 BUT NOT LIMITED TO, TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES AS DESCRIBED IN

1 SECTION 9 OF ARTICLE IX OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION OF 1963 shall
2 be considered a work project and may be carried forward into the
3 succeeding fiscal year for the purpose intended.
