- 1 EXPANSION PROJECT. ONE MILLION DOLLARS OF THIS AMOUNT SHALL BE
- 2 USED FOR STAFF TRAINING IN USE OF THE IMPROVED COMPUTER SYSTEM.
- 3 (2) THE COMMISSION SHALL APPOINT A COMPUTER PROJECT OVER-
- 4 SIGHT COMMITTEE OF NOT TO EXCEED 15 MEMBERS. THE COMMITTEE SHALL
