SENATE BILL No. 693

November 28, 1989, Introduced by Senators EHLERS, GAST, BINSFELD and CHERRY and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend section 8 of Act No. 136 of the Public Acts of 1969, entitled

"An act to require persons engaged in removing liquid industrial wastes from the premises of other persons to be licensed and bonded; to provide for the inspection and licensing of vehicles; to provide for the control of disposal of wastes; and to provide penalties for the violation of this act,"

being section 323.278 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Section 8 of Act No. 136 of the Public Acts of
- 2 1969, being section 323.278 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
- 3 amended to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 8. (1) The tank shall be kept tightly closed in tran-
- 5 sit, to prevent the escape of contents or odors and the outside
- 6 of all vehicles and accessory equipment shall be kept clean.
- 7 (2) The licensee shall dispose of all wastes in conformance
- 8 with the provisions of Act No. 245 of the Public Acts of 1929, as

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- 1 amended, being sections 323.1 to -323.12a 323.13 of the MICHIGAN
- 2 Compiled Laws. of 1948.
- 3 (3) The licensee shall keep records of all trips where the
- 4 pickup, hauling, or disposal of liquid wastes are involved. The
- 5 records shall state the date, source of the waste, quantity,
- 6 type, and the point and method of disposal, and total mileage of
- 7 the trip. Trip records for the last 2 months shall be carried on
- 8 the vehicle for inspection. The licensee shall preserve trip
- 9 records for 2 years.
- 10 (4) The licensee shall not dispose of wastes onto or into
- 11 the ground except at locations specifically approved by the
- 12 commission. Waste oil may be spread upon roadways and earth
- 13 surfaces for dust control or soil stabilization purposes-if
- 14 authorized in writing by the owner of such property and if done
- 15 in a manner that precludes hazardous or nuisance conditions. No
- 16 waste- WASTE shall NOT be placed in a location where -it could-
- 17 THE WASTE MAY enter any public or private drain, pond, stream, or
- 18 other body of surface WATER or -ground water GROUNDWATER.
- 19 Section 2. This amendatory act shall not take effect unless
- 20 Senate Bill No. 454 of the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
