

# SENATE BILL No. 714

December 6, 1989, Introduced by Senators FREDRICKS, WELBORN, ARTHURHULTZ, SHINKLE, CROPSEY, KELLY, CRUCE, CARL, O'BRIEN, BINSFELD, NICHOLS and DILLINGHAM and referred to the Committee on Education and Mental Health.

A bill to amend Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

"The school code of 1976,"

as amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 1174a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, as  
2       amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan  
3       Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1174a to read as  
4       follows:

5       SEC. 1174A. UPON WRITTEN OR ORAL REQUEST, A PUPIL NOT LESS  
6       THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE OR A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN OF A PUPIL  
7       LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE, WITHIN A REASONABLE PERIOD OF TIME  
8       AFTER THE REQUEST IS MADE, SHALL BE INFORMED OF THE CONTENT OF A  
9       COURSE AND MAY EXAMINE TEXTBOOKS AND OTHER CLASSROOM MATERIALS

1 THAT ARE PROVIDED TO THE PUPIL OR MATERIALS THAT ARE PRESENTED TO  
2 THE PUPIL IN THE CLASSROOM. THIS SECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE A  
3 SCHOOL BOARD TO PERMIT PUPIL OR PARENTAL EXAMINATION OF TEST  
4 QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS, SCORING KEYS, OR OTHER EXAMINATION INSTRU-  
5 MENTS OR DATA USED TO ADMINISTER AN ACADEMIC EXAMINATION. EACH  
6 SCHOOL BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH POLICIES AND PROCEDURES TO IMPLEMENT  
7 THIS SECTION.
