SENATE BILL No. 733

December 13, 1989, Introduced by Senator N. SMITH and referred to the Committee on State Affairs, Tourism, and Transportation.

A bill to authorize the state administrative board to convey certain state owned property in Branch county; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for the disposition of revenue derived from the conveyance.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The state administrative board, on behalf of the
- 2 state, may convey to the Branch area transit authority, for con-
- 3 sideration of \$1.00, property located in the city of Coldwater,
- 4 Branch county, Michigan, and described as follows:
- 5 Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 15, Town 6
- 6 South, Range 6 West, City of Coldwater, Branch County, Michigan,
- 7 thence N 89° 58' 40" E along the North line of said Section 15, a
- 8 distance of 1334.60 feet to the Northwest corner of the East 1/2
- 9 of the Northwest 1/4 of said Section 15 and the centerline of
- 10 Morse Street; thence S 00° 19' 33" E along the West line of the

- 11 to any easements, restrictions or conditions of record.
- 12 Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by this act shall provide
- 13 that the land shall be used exclusively for public purposes and
- 14 that upon termination of that use, or upon use for any other pur-
- 15 pose, title to the land shall revert immediately to the state,
- 16 with the state assuming no liability for improvements made at the
- 17 expense of the Branch area transit authority.
- 18 Sec. 3. The conveyance authorized by this act shall be by
- 19 quitclaim deed approved by the attorney general and shall reserve
- 20 to the state all rights to coal, oil, gas, and other mineral
- 21 rights found on, within or under the conveyed lands.
- 22 Sec. 4. The revenue received under this act shall be depos-
- 23 ited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.
