## SENATE BILL No. 11

January 11, 1989, Introduced by Senators SEDERBURG, EHLERS, WELBORN, POLLACK and N. SMITH and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend sections 4 and 7 of Act No. 388 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled

"An act to regulate political activity; to regulate campaign financing; to restrict campaign contributions and expenditures; to require campaign statements and reports; to regulate anonymous contributions; to regulate campaign advertising and literature; to provide for segregated funds for political purposes; to provide for the use of public funds for political purposes; to create a state campaign fund; to provide for reversion of, or refunding of, unexpended balances; to require reports; to provide appropriations; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

being sections 169.204 and 169.207 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Section 1. Sections 4 and 7 of Act No. 388 of the Public
- 2 Acts of 1976, being sections 169.204 and 169.207 of the Michigan
- 3 Compiled Laws, are amended to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 4. (1) "Contribution" means a payment, gift,
- 2 HONORARIUM, subscription, assessment, expenditure, contract,
- 3 payment for services, dues, advance, forbearance, loan, donation,
- 4 pledge or promise of money or anything of ascertainable monetary
- 5 value, whether or not conditional or legally enforceable, or a
- 6 transfer of anything of ascertainable monetary value to a person,
- 7 made for the purpose of influencing the nomination or election of
- 8 a candidate, or for the qualification, passage, or defeat of a
- 9 ballot question. An offer or tender of a contribution is not a
- 10 contribution if expressly and unconditionally rejected or
- 11 returned.
- 12 (2) Contribution includes the purchase of tickets or payment
- 13 of an attendance fee for events such as dinners, luncheons, ral-
- 14 lies, testimonials, and similar fund raising events; an
- 15 individual's own money or property other than the individual's
- 16 homestead used on behalf of that individual's candidacy; the
- 17 granting of discounts or rebates not available to the general
- 18 public; or the granting of discounts or rebates by broadcast
- 19 media and newspapers not extended on an equal basis to all candi-
- 20 dates for the same office.
- 21 (3) Contribution does not include:
- 22 (a) Volunteer personal services provided without compensa-
- 23 tion, or payments of costs incurred of less than \$250.00 in a
- 24 calendar year by an individual for personal travel expenses if
- 25 the costs are voluntarily incurred without any understanding or
- 26 agreement that the costs shall be, directly or indirectly,
- 27 repaid.

- 1 (b) Amounts received pursuant to a pledge or promise to the
- 2 extent that the amounts were previously reported as a
- 3 contribution.
- 4 (c) Food and beverages, not to exceed \$50.00 in value during
- 5 a calendar year, which are donated by an individual and for which
- 6 reimbursement is not given.
- 7 Sec. 7. (1) "Filed" means the receipt by the appropriate
- 8 filing official of a statement or report required to be filed
- 9 under this act.
- 10 (2) "Filer" means a person required to file a statement or
- 11 report pursuant to this act.
- 12 (3) "Filing official" means the official designated pursuant
- 13 to this act to receive required statements and reports.
- (4) "Fund raising event" means an event such as a dinner,
- 15 reception, testimonial, rally, auction, bingo, or similar affair
- 16 through which contributions are solicited or received by purchase
- 17 of a ticket, payment of an attendance fee, donations, -or-
- 18 PURCHASE OF chances for prizes, or through purchase of goods or
- 19 services.
- 20 (5) "Gift" means a payment, subscription, advance, forbear-
- 21 ance, rendering, or deposit of money, services, or anything of
- 22 value, unless consideration of equal or greater value is given
- 23 therefor.
- 24 (6) "HONORARIUM" MEANS A PAYMENT OF MONEY OR ANYTHING OF
- 25 VALUE RECEIVED BY A CANDIDATE, IF IT IS ACCEPTED AS CONSIDERATION
- 26 FOR AN APPEARANCE, SPEECH, OR ARTICLE. AN HONORARIUM DOES NOT
- 27 INCLUDE REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE COST OF TRANSPORTATION,

- 1 ACCOMMODATIONS, AND MEALS FOR THE CANDIDATE AND THE CANDIDATE'S
- 2 SPOUSE.
