

SENATE BILL No. 43

January 11, 1989, Introduced by Senators SCHWARZ and DE GROW and referred to the Committee on Education and Mental Health.

A bill to amend Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, entitled as amended

"The school code of 1976,"

as amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, by adding section 1277.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 451 of the Public Acts of 1976, as
2 amended, being sections 380.1 to 380.1852 of the Michigan
3 Compiled Laws, is amended by adding section 1277 to read as
4 follows:

5 SEC. 1277. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT, CONSIDERING
6 CRITERIA ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE BOARD, MAY ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT
7 A 3- TO 5-YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN AND CONTINUING SCHOOL
8 IMPROVEMENT PROCESS FOR EACH SCHOOL WITHIN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT.
9 THE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN SHALL INCLUDE, AT A MINIMUM, PROPOSED

1 METHODS FOR EFFECTIVE CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT. SCHOOL BUILDING
2 ADMINISTRATORS, TEACHERS, PUPILS, PARENTS OF PUPILS ATTENDING
3 THAT SCHOOL, AND OTHER RESIDENTS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL
4 PARTICIPATE IN THE PLANNING, DEVELOPMENT, AND IMPLEMENTATION OF
5 THE DISTRICT'S SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN. UPON REQUEST OF THE
6 BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ASSIST, AND THE
7 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO WHICH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT IS CON-
8 STITUEMENT MAY ASSIST, A SCHOOL DISTRICT IN THE DEVELOPMENT AND
9 IMPLEMENTATION OF A SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN. A SCHOOL IMPROVE-
10 MENT PLAN DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION SHALL BE UPDATED ANNUALLY BY
11 THE BOARD OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT.

12 (2) THE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL
13 BE MAINTAINED ON FILE WITH THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO
14 WHICH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT IS CONSTITUENT.

15 (3) THE STATE BOARD ANNUALLY SHALL REVIEW A RANDOM SAMPLING
16 OF SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLANS AND SUBMIT A REPORT ON SCHOOL
17 IMPROVEMENT ACTIVITIES PLANNED AND ACCOMPLISHED BY EACH OF THE
18 SCHOOL DISTRICTS THAT WERE PART OF THE SAMPLING TO THE SENATE AND
19 HOUSE COMMITTEES THAT HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR EDUCATION
20 LEGISLATION.
