

# SENATE BILL No. 84

February 1, 1989, Introduced by Senator FESSLER and referred to the  
Committee on Local Government and Veterans.

A bill to amend Act No. 278 of the Public Acts of 1909,  
entitled as amended

"An act to provide for the incorporation of villages and for  
revising and amending their charters; to provide for the levy and  
collection of taxes, borrowing of money, and issuance of bonds  
and other evidences of indebtedness; and to validate bonds issued  
and obligations previously incurred,"

as amended, being sections 78.1 to 78.28 of the Michigan Compiled  
Laws, by adding section 25a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1       Section 1. Act No. 278 of the Public Acts of 1909, as  
2 amended, being sections 78.1 to 78.28 of the Michigan Compiled  
3 Laws, is amended by adding section 25a to read as follows:

4       SEC. 25A. A VILLAGE SHALL NOT REQUIRE BY CHARTER OR ORDI-  
5 NANCE AND THE CHIEF OF POLICE OF THE VILLAGE SHALL NOT REQUIRE  
6 THAT A POLICE OFFICER EMPLOYED BY THE VILLAGE OR AN APPLICANT FOR

1 EMPLOYMENT AS A POLICE OFFICER RESIDE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS  
2 OF THE VILLAGE.
