

SENATE BILL No. 190

March 7, 1989, Introduced by Senators NICHOLS, POLLACK, CARL, WELBORN, DINGELL, SCHWARZ, BINSFELD, J. HART, GEO. HART, FREDRICKS, CROSEY, DILLINGHAM, BARCIA, POSTHUMUS, KELLY, DI NELLO, DE GROW, MILLER and O'BRIEN referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice and Urban Affairs.

A bill to repeal Act No. 195 of the Public Acts of 1935,
entitled

"An act to provide for the establishment of probation recovery camps; to prescribe the powers and duties of the state prison commission with respect thereto; to designate persons eligible for entrance in said camps, and to declare the effect of this act,"

being sections 798.1 to 798.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Act No. 195 of the Public Acts of 1935, being
2 sections 798.1 to 798.6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 repealed.

Section 2. This act shall not take effect unless Senate
Bill No. 187 of
the 85th Legislature is enacted into law.
