THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 THERE IS NO SUCH ORDER, IN THE COUNTY WHERE THE OBLIGEE OR
- 2 OBLIGOR RESIDES shall promptly request the agency of another
- 3 jurisdiction in which the obligor of a support order derives
- 4 income to enter the order for the purpose of obtaining income
- 5 withholding against that income. The office of the friend of the
- 6 court shall compile and transmit promptly to the agency of the
- 7 other jurisdiction all documentation required to enter a support
- 8 order for this purpose AND SHALL FILE THE DOCUMENTATION WITH THE
- 9 CLERK OF THE COURT. The office of the friend of the court also
- 10 shall transmit immediately to the agency of the other jurisdic-
- 11 tion a certified copy of any subsequent modifications of the sup-
- 12 port order. If the office of the friend of the court receives
