

SENATE BILL No. 708

November 30, 1989, Introduced by Senators CROPSEY, WELBORN, GEAKE, CARL and DI NELLO and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend section 2 of Act No. 79 of the Public Acts of 1971, entitled

"Age of majority act of 1971,"

being section 722.52 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Section 1. Section 2 of Act No. 79 of the Public Acts of
2 1971, being section 722.52 of the Michigan Compiled Laws, is
3 amended to read as follows:

4 Sec. 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
5 contrary, a person who is AT LEAST 18 years of age ~~but less than~~
6 ~~21 years of age when this act takes effect, and a person who~~
7 ~~attains 18 years of age thereafter, is deemed to be~~ ON OR AFTER
8 JANUARY 1, 1972 IS an adult of legal age for all purposes
9 whatsoever, ~~and shall have the same duties, liabilities,~~
10 ~~responsibilities, rights and legal capacity as persons heretofore~~

1 ~~acquired at 21 years of age~~ EXCEPT IF IT IS OTHERWISE PROVIDED
2 IN THE STATE CONSTITUTION OF 1963. NOTWITHSTANDING THIS SECTION,
3 A COURT MAY ORDER SUPPORT PAYMENTS FOR A CHILD 18 YEARS OF AGE OR
4 OLDER AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 17A OF CHAPTER 84 OF THE REVISED
5 STATUTES OF 1846, BEING SECTION 552.17A OF THE MICHIGAN COMPILED
6 LAWS.
