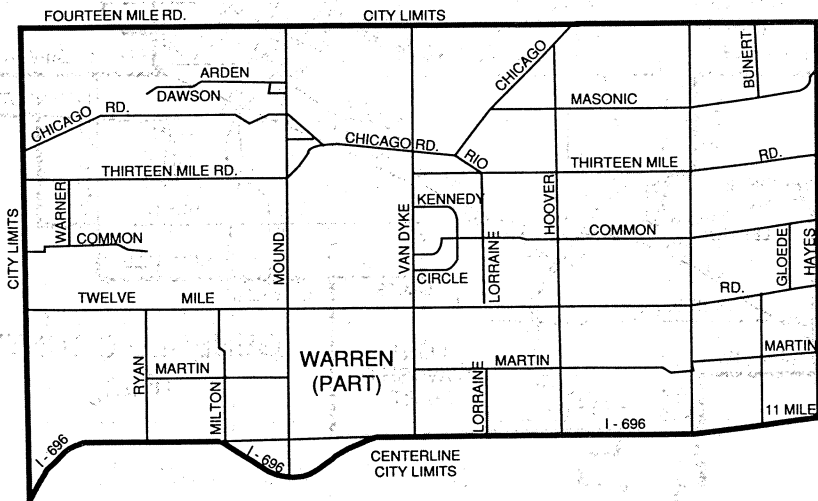

**Biography:** Democrat, of Warren; born August 31, 1943, at Detroit; B.A., Western Michigan University, 1965; M.A., guidance and counseling, Wayne State University, 1971; single; teacher; member, executive committee, Macomb County Democrats, 18th Congressional District Democrats, UAW; President, Warren City Council, 1969-70, at age 25 youngest person in city history to be so elected, running first in 53-candidate field; member, Macomb County Board of Commissioners, 1970-74; chairman, board Judiciary Subcommittee and member, Committees on Personnel, Budget and Finance; reelected, 1972, receiving the highest percentage of vote in any contested commissioner race; chairman, board Legislative Subcommittee and member, board Committees on Judiciary, Finance, Personnel and Budget; first elected to House of Representatives, November 1974; vice chairman, House Corporations and Finance Committee and member, Labor, Elections, and Tourist Industry Relations Committees. 1975-76; nominated for Outstanding Young Man of the Year Award by Warren Jaycees, 1977; chairman, House City Government Committee, 1981-82; member, Joint Committee on Administrative Rules, 1983-86; House Appropriations Committee, 1987-88; member, Colleges and Universities, Corporations and Finance, House Oversight, Insurance Committees, Subcommittee on Long-Term Health Care and Medicare Supplemental Insurance.
